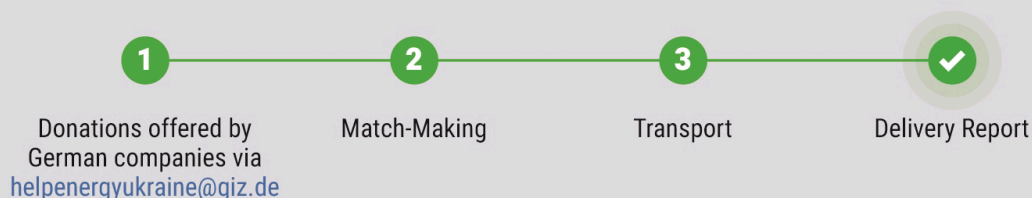


Donation Campaign for the Ukrainian Energy Sector



After the start of the full-scale Russian invasion to Ukraine, the Ukrainian Ministry of Energy (MinEnergy) sent a request for help to the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK). Technical goods are needed, for the repair and maintenance of electricity and gas networks and other energy infrastructure in Ukraine, which was damaged or destroyed by the war. The donation campaign for the Ukrainian energy sector supports to provide these goods. The campaign is financed by BMWK and supported by the Secretariat of the German-Ukrainian Energy Partnership, which is implemented by GIZ.

You donate, we facilitate!



Donation process

1. Please send us your donation to helpenergyukraine@giz.de.
2. The EP-Secretariat forwards your offer to the Ministry of Energy of Ukraine which matches the donation to a final recipient.
3. We inform you that a recipient was found and start preparing the documents for transportation with you.
4. We arrange the pick-up of your donation and facilitate a delivery to the Polish-Ukrainian border. Alternatively, you can deliver the goods to the given address yourself.
5. Our Ukrainian partner organisation GoLocal picks up the goods from the Polish-Ukrainian border and transports them to the final recipients.
6. The final recipient confirms the delivery, and all partners receive a confirmation.
