





Donation Campaign for the Ukrainian Energy Sector



Since the start of the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine, Ukraine's energy infrastructure has been severely damaged or destroyed. In response, the Ukrainian Ministry of Energy (MinEnergo) requested assistance from the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK). Technical goods are urgently needed for repairs and maintenance.

The donation campaign for Ukraine's energy sector has already facilitated the delivery of over 31.700 energy goods to Ukraine (as of September 2025). The campaign is funded by BMWE and supported by the Secretariat of the German-Ukrainian Energy Partnership, implemented by GIZ.











Donation process

- 1. **Please send your donation to**: helpenergyukraine@giz.de. Your donation is tax-deductible.
- 2. The EP Secretariat forwards your offer to the Ministry of Energy of Ukraine, which matches the donation to a final recipient.
- 3. We inform you once a recipient has been identified and start preparing the necessary transportation documents with you.
- 4. We arrange the pick-up of your donation through our
 Ukrainian partner organization GoLocal and facilitate
 delivery to Ukraine. Alternatively, you may deliver the goods
 to a hub at the Polish-Ukrainian border yourself.
- 5. GoLocal transports the goods to the final recipients.
- 6. The final recipient confirms delivery, and all partners receive a confirmation.
